

Getting Started: Accessing My eLearning Vista

For Vista 3.x

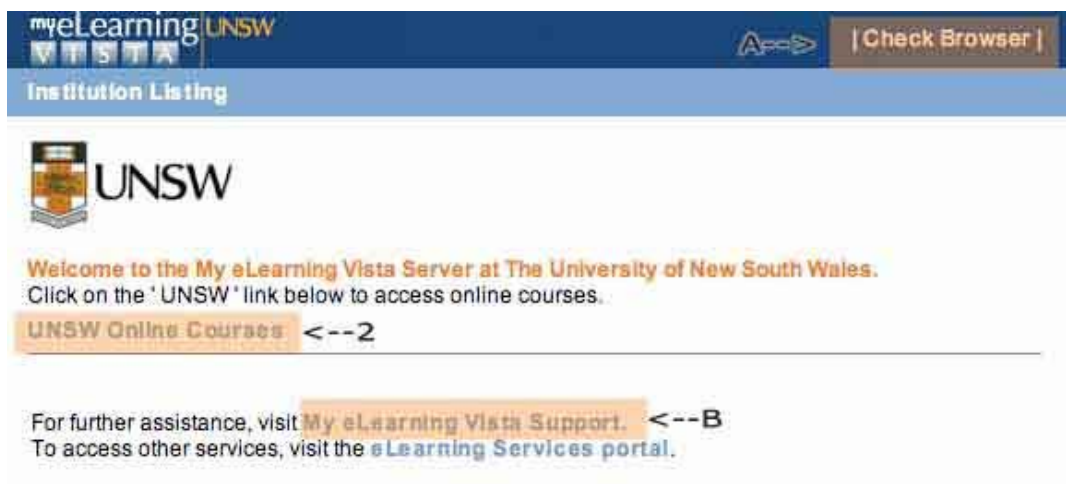
My eLearning Vista is the centrally supported learning management system at UNSW. It is used to provide online learning and teaching environments to supplement face-to-face teaching, distance learning and provide a small number of fully online courses. This guide illustrates the steps required to log in to Vista.

Steps:

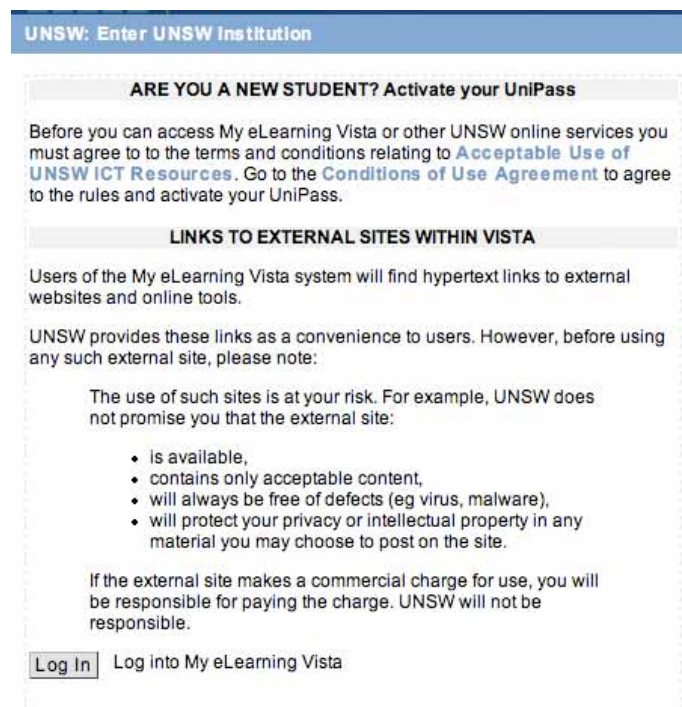
- Using a web browser enter the web address::

- Institution Listing** - This page is the Institution Listing page. It can be bookmarked for future access.
 - Use the Check Browser link to test whether your computer is properly set up to use My eLearning Vista.
 - The My eLearning Vista Support Site provides assistance and alerts for My eLearning Vista.
- Click on the UNSW Online Courses link to access the next page.



- UNSW: Enter UNSW Institution** - This screen provides information about terms and conditions of use for this service. Please read this information carefully. Click the Log In button to continue logging in.



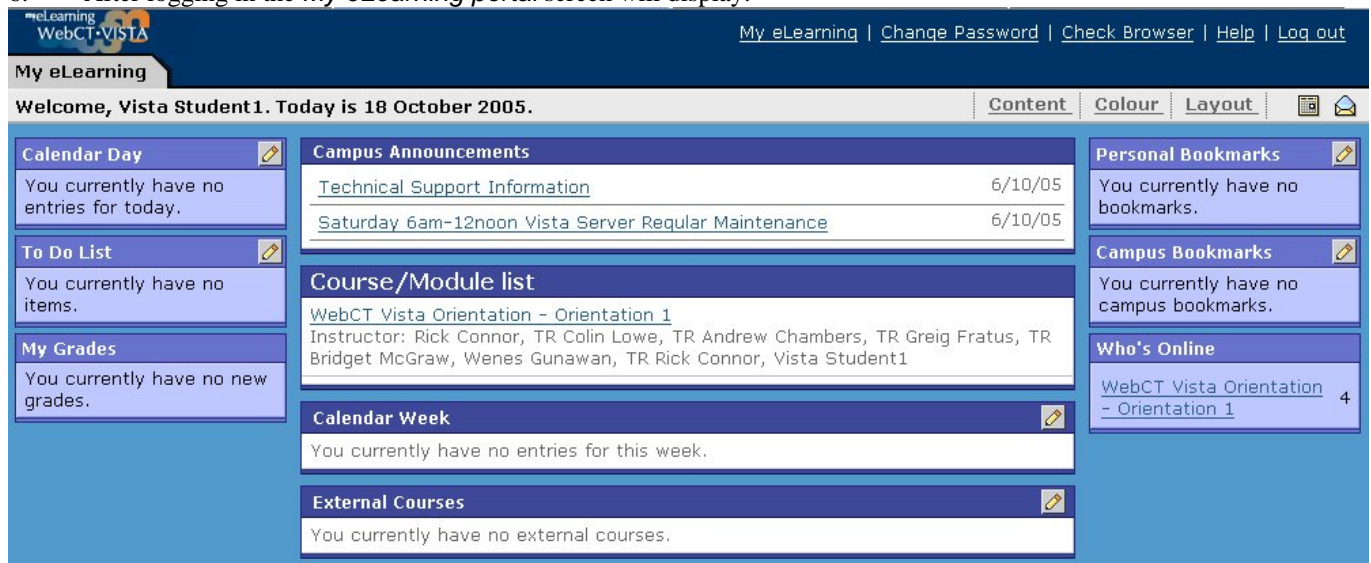
- Login Screen** - Type in your **Username** and **Password**. Your username is your UNSW staff or student number. Your password is your UniPass. Click **OK**.



5. When you log in to Vista a Java security certificate may display requiring you to accept the certificate before using Vista. Click the **Always** button. (**NB:** It is important to wait until the certificate loads completely, and to accept the certificate before clicking on the Vista page. Vista may otherwise end the session and you will need to start again.)



6. After logging in the *My eLearning portal* screen will display.
